2018 Clearbrook-Gonvick Trap Club

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Your student has expressed interest in participating in the 2018 Trap Club. This is Clearbrook-Gonvick's 2nd season in an increasingly popular nationwide activity. I wanted to provide you information so you can discuss it with your student and decide if your student will be able to participate.

- Clearbrook-Gonvick students participate at a trap field just northeast of Clearbrook known to many as "Ruffy Brook".
- The season consists of 2 practice weeks, 5 competition weeks, 1 fun week and the state Trap championship. The season **starts the first week in April and goes through May**.
- Students who wish to participate in **Track and Field and Trap Club may do so** as we have an agreement with the track coaches.
- If your student is in Jr. High and/or Track and Field, they will shoot on Wednesdays at 2:45. All others will shoot Monday at 4:15 PM.
- Scores are entered in to an online database by the head coach which serves as competition with other teams.
- Students shoot **50 rounds of ammunition per week** and may bring extra if they wish to shoot additional rounds provided there is time and extra clay targets.
- Clearbrook-Gonvick School provides the clay targets and coaching.
- **Families provide the \$35 registration fee, their own shotgun, ammunition, safety glasses and ear protection (team apparel may be available to purchase (optional)).**
- Participants may use **12 GA or 20 GA Shotguns with 7-1/2 or 8 Shot** target loads.
- The Trap Championship takes place in Alexandria on June 11th. More information will be given when that date draws closer.
- **Firearms and ammunition are NOT allowed on school property. Participants must make arrangements to keep firearms and ammunition off school property.** (If you need possible solutions to this, please contact the Head Coach)
- Participants must have completed firearm safety and have the number available when registering. If the participant has not completed firearm safety, the Clay Target League offers a "SAFE" course which consists of online training combined with a demonstration of safety at the range.
- Students are expected to behave in a safe and responsible manner **and** in accordance with MN State High School League rules and regulations and MN State Law. Any conduct not meeting these requirements may result in immediate dismissal from the team, possible disciplinary action and law enforcement contact (if necessary).

If your student wishes to participate, please complete the information on the back side of this form and return to Andy Anderson at Clearbrook-Gonvick School. Please return by Friday, February 23, 2018. Shortly after, you will receive an email with a link to register.
