#### What is ECFE?

Early Childhood Family Education offers education and support for families with young children, through parent/child classes, special events, Family Resource Library, WIC clinic support, and a wide range of referral resources.

## What does a typical ECFE class include?

Most ECFE classes meet once a week and include:

#### **Parent-Child Activity Time:**

Families explore the classroom, play and do learning activities planned by licensed early childhood teachers.

#### **Parent Discussion Time:**

Parents and the parent facilitator meet and share information, ideas and experiences about child development, parenting and current issues.

#### **Children's Activity Time:**

When parents have their discussion time, the children have a snack with the licensed Early Childhood Teacher, and then have time to play, learn and interact with each other.

#### Printmaking!

Introduce *printmaking* by dipping apples in paint and "printing" them on paper!



#### Do it together recipe:

Crock pot applesauce:

Take ten large apples, peeled, cored and cut into chunks. Put them in a crock pot along with ½ cup water, ½ teaspoon cinnamon, and ¾ cup sugar. Cover and cook on high for 3-4 hours or low for 8-10 hours. Take a potato masher and mash. This can be eaten warm or cold. Refrigerate the remaining sauce.

#### Math time!

Go on a nature walk and collect items that interest your child (rocks, pinecones, leaves, feathers...) Count how many items there are. Ask, "How many pinecones do you have?" or "How many orange leaves did you find?" Another idea... find out which group has more or less items.



#### **Fine Motor Activity!**

on paper to "decorate" a fall picture!

#### Snack Time!

Here's a snack you can eat together.

Buy a red apple, green apple and a yellow apple. Ask which apple your child likes best. Ask questions about the apples... "Which apple is the sweetest or softest?"



# WHAT?! Crying, defiance and clingy behavior are MILESTONES?!?!

YES, as crazy as it sounds...they are social-emotional milestones. Here are other milestones to watch for and celebrate.

#### 2 - 3 MONTHS

- Shows feelings by crying or smiling.
- Begins to smile at parent.
- Follows parent with eyes.
- Enjoys being hugged and cuddled

#### **4 MONTHS**

- Smiles spontaneously, especially at people.
- Shows excitement by waving arms and legs.
- Calms and stops crying when comforted (most of the time).
- Enjoys playing with people and imitating smiles and frowns.

#### **6 MONTHS**

- Knows familiar faces and begins to know if someone is a stranger.
- Enjoys playing with others, especially family (such as "peek-a-boo").
- · Likes to look at self in mirror.
- Responds to other people's emotions and often seems happy.
- Makes sounds to express happiness or displeasure.

#### 9 MONTHS

- Shows feelings by smiling, crying and pointing.
- · Prefers certain toys.
- Clings to familiar adults.
- Cries when parent leaves and is shy around strangers.
- · Responds to own name.

#### 18 MONTHS

- Imitates your behavior Tries new things with familiar adults nearby.
- Hands things to others as part of play.
- Shows feelings, for example, temper tantrums, fear of strangers, affection with familiar people or clinging to a familiar adult in new situations.
- Points to show things to others.

#### 2 YEARS

- Plays briefly beside other children, and gets excited when with other children.
- Imitates others, especially adults and older children.
- Shows more and more independence.
- Shows defiance, such as doing what he/she was told not to do.
- Begins to play with other children, as in chasing one another.

#### 3 YEARS

- Shows concern and affection for others without prompting.
- Copies adults and friends (for example, runs when other children run).
- Takes turns in games.
- Separates easily from parents.
- Shows a wide range of feelings.
- Enjoys routines and may get upset with a major change.
- Dresses and undresses self.
- Enjoys helping with simple household tasks.
- Verbalizes toilet needs and may be toilet trained during the day.

#### 12 MONTHS

- Prefers certain people and toys.
- Imitates sounds, gestures or actions to get Parent's attention.
- Cries when parent leaves and is shy around strangers.
- Puts arm or leg out to help with dressing
- Enjoys playing games like "peek-a-boo" and "pat-a-cake."

#### 4 YEARS

- Plays cooperatively with other children.
- Negotiates solutions to conflicts.
- Prefers playing with other children than playing alone.
- Enjoys doing new things.
- Becomes more creative in make-believe play.
- Confuses what's real and what's makebelieve.
- Expresses likes and dislikes.
- Seeks new experiences.

# School Readiness Classes

If your child is eligible to attend Kindergarten in the 2019-2020 school year, you may enroll him/her in this class.

School Readiness is a great opportunity for your child to spend time in a semi-structured classroom with daily routines while working on academic and social skills. Parental involvement is important and required for your child to participate in this class. We have a variety of options for you to consider for involvement. We also have some possible options to assist in transportation to or from classes. No family will be excluded because of an inability to pay.

#### **Have fun Comparing!**

Math is important in daily life and in school. Who is taller? How much paper do we need to wrap this present? Is this container big enough? To answer these questions, we think about size and compare.

#### Big and Little!

Math is more than numbers and counting. Children learn important math skills by doing simple hands-on activities, like sorting objects by size and comparing them. You can help your child learn math as you play and talk together.

Enjoy these games with your child. Don't worry about the right answer. Young children learn math skills over time. As they grow older, they are able to understand things in a more adult way.

- On walks, look for big and little leaves, trees, buildings, rocks, and flowers.
- Compare shoes, your child's and your own. Ask: Whose shoe is bigger? How can you tell? With older children, add another person's show. Whose is biggest? Smallest? In the middle?
- Say to your child: Walk around the room.
   Can you find something that is as tall as you are? Taller? Shorter? How can you tell?
- Let your child help sort and match objects by size or color: clean socks, toys, shells, etc.
