

Process of obtaining a Driver's License at Clearbrook-Gonvick School

Step One: Classroom Instruction

- 30 hours (ten 3-hour sessions) of classroom instruction
- Cost: \$70.00

Step Two: Obtain Instructional Permit

- Must be 15 years of age
- Must have blue card indicating that you have completed driver education class
- Must have certified birth certificate
- Must pass knowledge test

Step Three: Behind the Wheel Instruction

- Must have instructional permit
- 6 hours of behind the wheel training – most students will drive during the spring and summer
- Cost: \$185.00

Step Four: Road Test with State Examiner to obtain Minnesota Driver's License

- Must be 16 years of age
- Must have white card indicating that you have completed behind the wheel training
- Must have completed supervised driving log

Fees are as of September 2015

Fall classroom usually begins the end of October and Spring classroom usually begins in early March. We recommend that students are 15 by around January 1 for the Fall class and 15 by August 1 for the Spring class. These ages are not set in stone, just a recommendation so that students do not forget everything they learned by the time they take their written test.
